



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Downtown Corridor: *Tree Removal on Flower Street*

Attention Residents and Business Owners

The Exposition Construction Authority, in preparation for the construction of the Exposition Light Rail Line, will be **removing trees along Flower Street in order to accommodate rail construction activities.** On behalf of the Authority, the design-build contractor FCI/Fluor/Parsons will work in various areas along the Exposition right-of-way.

- When: **Starting on Monday, January 8, 2007**
- Where: **Along Flower Street, from Washington Blvd. to Adams Blvd.**
- Time: **During the hours of 6:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.**
- Duration: **Approximately three (3) weeks**

Activity: Thirty-four (34) Palm Trees along Flower Street will be removed in order to accommodate rail construction activities. They will be temporarily relocated and stored off-site until all major construction activities are completed, and then replanted as part of the new landscaping design for Flower Street.

Traffic Impacts: There will be no major impacts to traffic due to this work activity.

Safety Tip: The trees are very tall and cranes will be used to remove them. **Please keep clear of the work area, do not enter the construction work zone and obey all posted construction signs and flagmen.**
