#### BACKGROUND:

In early 2007, the Exposition Construction Authority began the Phase 2 study to extend Phase 1 of the Expo Line from the current planned terminus at Venice/Robertson in Culver City to Santa Monica. Several large-scale community meetings and dozens of additional key stakeholder meetings with neighborhood associations, chambers of commerce, elected officials, businesses, schools and universities have been held to discuss the alternatives that were studied and to obtain feedback from the public. The Draft Environmental Impact Report was released in January 2009 and the Final Environmental Impact Report is currently being developed and will be completed by the end of the year.
